

Spring Is Here 🤳



The vernal equinox falls on March 20 this year.

It is a day when daylight and darkness are approximately equal in length. On this day, the sun crosses the celestial equator —the "line" in the sky above Earth's midline. It marks the end of winter and the start of spring in the northern hemisphere and the end of summer and the start of fall in the southern hemisphere. The Chinese have celebrated the equinox with feats of egg balancing, where an unbroken egg, a symbol of fertility, is said to bring good luck and prosperity for the rest of the season. Early equinox celebrations in Germanic countries centered around Ostara, the Germanic goddess of spring. In Persia, the Achaemenid dynasty celebrated the equinox with the festival of Nowruz, meaning "new day." And finally, in Central America, the Mayans celebrated this day for centuries with a viewing of the sun as it sets on the El Castillo pyramid in Mexico.


